## How We Reach Out

This is the harvest season and the time when churches traditionally make their stewardship campaigns for the coming year. This year, our stewardship Sunday will be November 19. On that Sunday we ask you to bring your pledge cards to be placed on the altar. Though stewardship is an ongoing expectation, on that particular day, each of you are asked to recall and reaffirm your pledge to do these five things:

- Pray for the church and its mission and ministry. This is the singular most important thing we can do.
- Please attend worship and Christian discipleship programs. Your presence sends a strong message to those who might consider joining us.
- Your church needs you to be faithful in your giving. Current giving is sufficient to pay the bills, but little is left for

reaching out. If we cannot reach out, we cannot grow. If we can't grow we will wither. I ask you to consider your efforts to be an investment in the future of this church and the work it will do for the kingdom. As we grow, this responsibility will be shared with others.

I will ask each of you to consider giving a biblical tithe of 10% of your income each year. Tithing will be difficult for some. In that event, please consider "growing toward a tithe" by giving 1% extra this year and adding 1% annually in the years to follow until you reach a tithe.

Our financial team has asked that I encourage you to reconsider the targets of your giving. It may seem strange, but we ask you to divert some of your gifts from the building fund to the general fund. Proportionally, the building fund is

healthy while the general fund could use the additional support.

- When we call for labor, please come if you are able. If you have limitations, we will find something to accommodate you. The hands on components of our mission are just as essential as your money gifts. Our effort to make a difference in the world translates into people wanting to know more about us. Additionally, doing many things ourselves is a chance for fellowship, gives us pride in accomplishment and ownership, as well as a cost saving measure.
- Use your witness. Our best method of reaching out is to share your story of faith with others.

Stewardship is so much more than paying bills. Our job is reaching out to sharing Christ, and this is how we do it. I challenge and push you to do more, to give more, and to be more. If I am not challenging and pushing you, I am failing to do my job. I do not push you to condemn or embarrass, I push you because I love you.

You have a wonderful message to share about a loving God and what God has done for you. That story must be told more now than ever

before. Your stewardship permits this to happen.

It continues to be my great privilege to serve God and this church as your pastor.

The charge conference directs the work of the church and gives general oversight to the church council, reviews and

evaluates the mission and ministry of the church, sets salaries for the pastor and staff, elects the members of the church council, and recommends candidates for ordained ministry.

Our Charge Conference will be held Sunday, November 19, 4:00pm, at Geyer Springs UMC, 5500 Geyer Springs Road. It will be under the direction of

our Circuit Elder, Rev. Phil Hathcock.

All are invited to attend this conference. You will find it educational and enlightening.

Thank you! Thank you! The donations and the volunteer hours have been unbelievable. We have had a lot going on this fall and we have


really pushed all of you.
